

ABOUT HANAMI

HANAMI is strengthening the EU-Japan collaboration around HPC by gathering key research institutes and high-end supercomputers in one environment to tackle exascale challenges for climate, biomedical and material science. The HANAMI consortium is **led by the French** Alternative Energies and Atomic Energy Commission (CEA) in France and includes 14 European organisations and 10 Japanese institutions.



ROADMAP FOR THE FUTURE

The HANAMI consortium promotes a longstanding partnership around HPC between the EU and Japan. Thus, a significant effort is dedicated to engaging with relevant stakeholders to ensure the sustainability of the collaboration. HANAMI aims to define a sustainable framework for the cooperation between European and Japanese counterparts.

HIGH-LEVEL SYMPOSIUM (HLS)

This is a **landmark event for strengthening research and technological ties between Europe and Japan** in the fast-advancing field of supercomputing. The HLS aims to have leading researchers, policymakers, and stakeholders from both regions together to discuss the future of HPC and the role of international collaboration in addressing global challenges.
